

PARK PASEO POOL FACILITIES

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Christamon Clubhouse Pool and Prosa Pool are non-smoking facilities.

Hours are subject to change for needed maintenance or service. Pools are heated from Irvine Unified Spring Break (typically includes Easter) weekend through Mid-October. Spa is heated year-round.

KEYS

These are issued in pairs to each home and are obtained at the Clubhouse from the Manager. Keys should be available upon request when using locked facilities or facilities requiring a key. Keys to facilities are to be returned to Manager when moving out of Park Paseo.

SWIM TEAM

Individual homeowners may not reserve either pool facility for exclusive use. THE POOLS ARE FOR ASSOCIATION MEMBERS AND THEIR GUESTS. THE ASSOCIATION ASSUMES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY INJURY OR ACCIDENT IN CONNECTION WITH USE, OR FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE TO PERSONAL PROPERTY.

POOLS / SPA / WADER

DEFINITIONS

1. Adults are designated as 18 years or older.
2. Youths:
 - A. 14 to 17 years old without parents present may swim with parental permission and a key in their possession.
 - B. 13 years old or under must be accompanied by an adult.
 - C. All guests must meet the Association guidelines for swimmers. Guest swimmers under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

GENERAL RULES

1. Use the pool at your own risk. The Association assumes no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use of for any loss or damage to personal property.
2. If lifeguards are on duty, they are the final authority regarding pool and water safety conditions; they must be obeyed at all times. At all other times the Manager or pool monitor, swim coaches, and Board members are the final authority.
3. All facility keys must be furnished upon request and no resident is admitted to the pools without his assigned key. Any person without his assigned key will be asked to leave the premises.
4. Guests may make use of the swimming pools/spa/wader only when accompanied by the resident host.
5. All swimmers must shower before entering the pool and must wear a bathing suit (no ragged-edged

- garments are allowed). Showers are only for persons using the facilities and not for individual personal hygiene not related to use of the facility.
6. Children that are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper under bathing suits while using the swimming pools/spa/wader.
 7. Any individual with a contagious malady, open sores or diarrhea will not be permitted to use the swimming pools/spa/wader.
 8. For hair shoulder length or longer, it is recommended that hair be tied back, braided or a cap worn (hair clogs the drains).
 9. The following rules will apply:
 - No running or “horse-play” on pool deck.
 - No “horse-play” in the swimming pools/spa/wader.
 - No ball/Frisbee or object throwing.
 - No eating or gum chewing in pool area.
 - No skateboards, bicycles/tricycles, skates/roller blades inside fenced areas.
 - No bottles or other glass containers/objects inside fenced areas.
 - No pets inside fenced areas except official Service Dogs (with official government documentation).
 - No unduly loud and disturbing noise inside the fenced areas.
 - No radios/playback sound devices without headsets inside the fenced area.
 - No diving from benches, tables or other facility structures, such as spa equipment room inside fenced area.
 - Absolutely no pool furniture allowed in the pools/spa/wader at any time (may damage fiberglass coating as well as patio furniture).
 - No rafts, inflatable toys, diving rings during busy periods. Busy periods require consideration for others sharing pool.
 - No “boogie boards” or surfboards.
 10. Lap swimming is recommended in the far two (2) lanes closest to the spa to minimize swim traffic close to the pool stairs.
 11. Any damage to equipment or furnishings must be reported promptly.
 12. The “buddy system” is recommended to be used by all swimmers at all times. For safety – no one should swim alone.
 13. All gates must remain closed and locked at all times. This is to protect against small children entering or leaving unaccompanied, trespassing and vandalism.
 14. Adult residents/members may bring up to 12 guests with one key. Adults planning youth or family events with more than 12 guests must notify the Association office at least 24 hours in advance to avoid conflicts with other pre-planned events.
 15. Anyone caught jumping the fence to any gated facility will be asked to leave the facility for the day. If the same person is caught jumping the fence for a second time, he will be asked to leave the facility for the day and a letter will be sent to the homeowner. Non-resident violators will be turned over to the police as trespassers.
 16. Violation of these rules may result in suspension of privileges.

SPA

1. **NO ONE UNDER** 18 years of age is allowed in the spa without being accompanied by and under the direct supervision of a homeowner/resident parent.
2. Elderly persons, pregnant women, infants and those with health conditions requiring medical care should consult a physician before entering spa.
3. Hot water immersion while under the influence of alcohol, narcotics, drugs or medicines may lead to serious consequences and is not recommended.
4. The “buddy system” is recommended to be used by all bathers at all times. For safety – no one should bathe alone.

5. Children who are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper under bathing suits while using the swimming pools/spa/wader.
6. The spa is for therapeutic use and the temperature is maintained at 102 degrees. Long exposure may result in nausea, dizziness or fainting.
7. Absolutely no glass containers in spa area.
8. Absolutely no pool furniture allowed in the spa at any time (may damage fiberglass spa coating as well as patio furniture).
9. All general rules concerning ball playing, loud noise, radio/playback devices, running/horse-play, wheeled conveyances, floating devices, pets also apply to the spa area.

WADER

1. The wading pool is for children 5 years of age and under.
2. All children in the wading pool area must be under the direct supervision of an adult at all times.
3. All general rules concerning food, gum, glass containers, diving, jumping, ball playing, loud noise, radio/playback devices, running/horse-play, wheeled conveyances, floating devices, pets also apply to the wader area.
4. Children who are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper under bathing suits while using the swimming pools/spa/wader.
5. Violation of these rules may cause a verbal warning, time-out period, ejection for the day, or a suspension of privileges.
6. Absolutely no pool furniture allowed in the wader at any time (may damage fiberglass wader coating as well as patio furniture).
