

NEW ELECTRONIC KEY FOBS



New electronic fobs are now used to access all Park Paseo HOA facilities (including Clubhouse Pool, Prosa Pool, Tennis Courts, and Hot Tub). The old mechanical (Medeco) keys have been disabled. Every Park Paseo resident (homeowner or tenant) must pick up the new key fobs in person at the HOA office at the clubhouse on Monday, Wednesday, or Friday between 9am - 5pm. Please bring a valid photo ID and your current metal (Medeco) keys to collect new key fobs.

Several records were broken this season, including some that stood for over 30 years. River McIntyre now holds the records for the boys 9-10 backstroke and breaststroke. Ivan Liu claimed the titles in the boys 5-6 breaststroke and freestyle. Kade Baker is the new record holder in the boys 7-8 freestyle. Nyah Lin now has the top time in the women's 15-18 backstroke. At the city championship meet to close out the season, the Northstars had many swimmers place in the top 16, including all four record holders, Sarah Chao, Everett Chen, Vicki Edney, Aaron Josenhans, Tyler Lin, and Violet Liu. The Northstars provides kids ages 5-18 the opportunity to become better swimmers and to have fun both in and out of the pool, building a stronger community at practices, meets, and team events such as cardboard boat races, family potlucks, game nights, sleepovers, scavenger hunts, and field games. The team also offers an opportunity for older swimmers to become coaches. The team would like to thank all of the 2023 coaches – Angie, Sidney, Simran, Tyler, Keira, Jalen, Josh, Kristoffer, Noah, Trevor, and Nyah. The Northstars also wish to thank the outgoing board members and welcome the 2024 board – we thank you all for your dedication to the team!
