NorthStars 2025 Wrap-up

The Park Paseo Northstars closed out another great season at the league-wide championship meet on August 9 as the league celebrated its 40th anniversary. This year, our team was full, with 130 swimmers ages 5-18 learning to swim and improving their technique. Each week, we celebrated the swimmers' time improvements, top finishes, and record-breaking swims. At the championship meet, the Northstars competed against all twenty other teams in the league and eleven of our swimmers placed in the top 16 in their events to score points for the team.

Building community is one of the most special parts of joining the neighborhood swim team. Outside of the pool, the kids and coaches bonded at Fun Friday events like a scavenger hunt, field games, walk to boba, and the annual team sleepover and breakfast. The swimmers create a bond that lasts into their teen years, when they have the opportunity to become team coaches. As coaches, kids build leadership, communication, and problem-solving skills. We would like to extend a huge thank you to this year's coaches: Head Coach Sydney Lin; Head Assistant Coach Simran Patel; Assistant Coaches Keira, Jalen, Noah, Kristoffer, Josh, Trevor, and Nyah; and Volunteer Coaches Aditi, Olivia, Evie, Zoe, Audrey, Deron, Anaya, Ariana, and Izumi. The team would also like to thank the Board Members for their service and all the hard work that goes into a successful season and to the HOA for working closely with us and allowing us to use the pool. Pool/Spa Rules

Please note that pool furniture is not to be relocated to the spa area and vice versa. The pool and spa gates are to remain closed unless actively using them. Please do not prop the gates open.

NO ONE UNDER 18 years of age is allowed in the spa without being accompanied by and under the direct supervision of a homeowner/resident parent. The wading pool is for children 5 years of age and under. All children in the wading pool area must be under the direct supervision of an adult at all times.

Pets/Animals Rules Reminder

All dogs must be kept on a leash at all the time in public areas. The Owner is fully responsible for cleaning after the dog, and any damage or injury caused by the dog. In addition, please be respectful of your neighbors by making sure that your dog or other pets do not make excessive noise any time of the day, particularly during the night.

Community Updates and Improvements

We are excited to share several ongoing and completed projects aimed at enhancing our community:

- New beautiful lighting has been installed around the pools, creating a welcoming atmosphere. More light replacements to come.
- Upgraded landscaping on Orange Arrow and around the pool by the clubhouse adds to the beauty of our surroundings.
- We are currently reviewing proposals for landscaping improvements in other areas of the community.
- The city permits for the removal of the marked Eucalyptus trees have been approved and we are currently scheduling the removals.
- Due to the age of our community, we have undertaken many sprinkler and valve repairs. If you notice a malfunctioning sprinkler, please inform management.
- We are working with our vendor to till the volleyball courts sand and get new nets as well as repair the court lighting.
- We are working with our vendor to get the Tot Lots repaired.
- The clubhouse parking lot has been resurfaced and is looking fantastic.






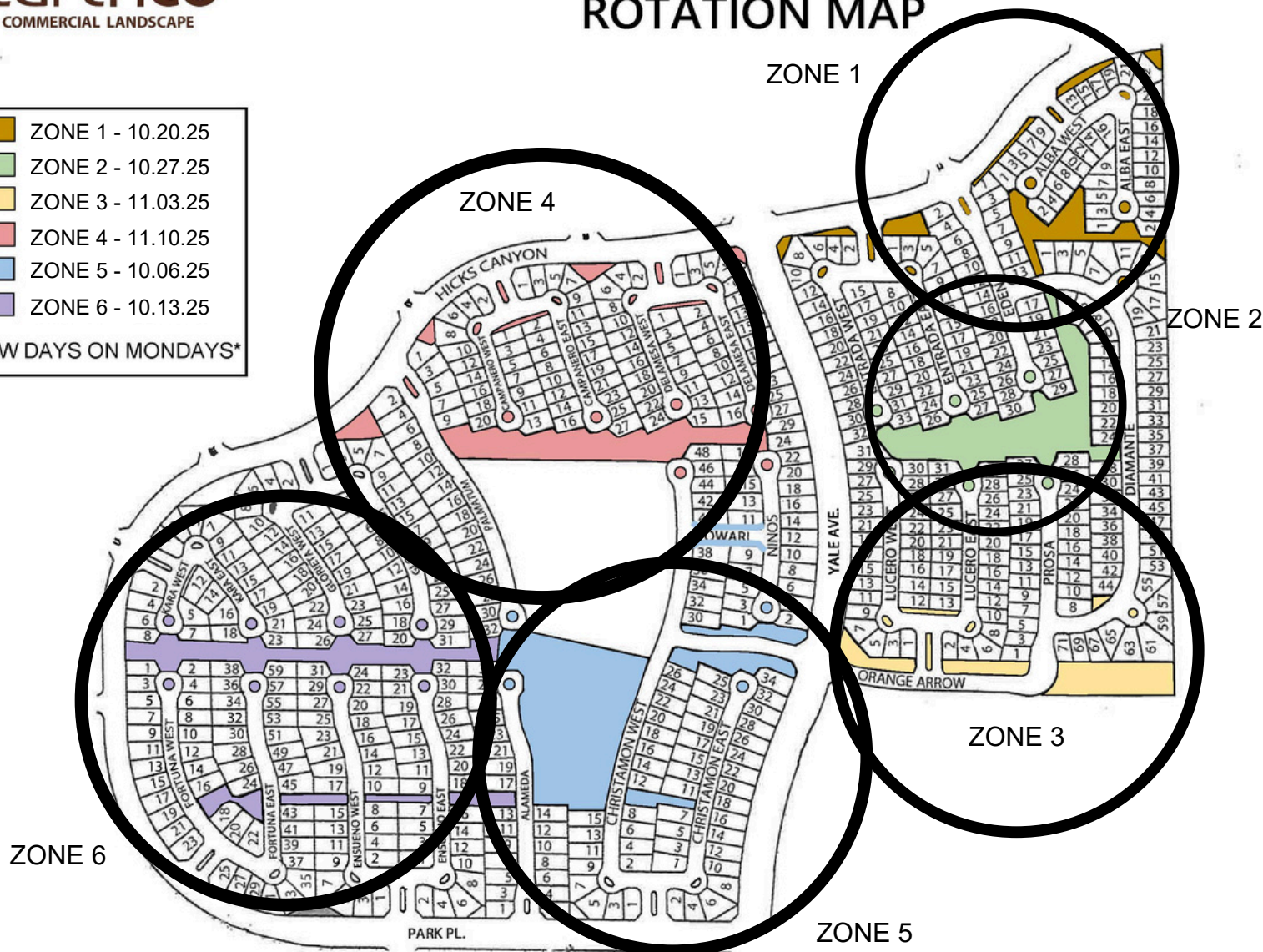


PARK PASEO

ELECTRONIC KEY FOBS

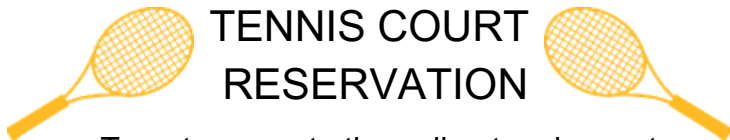


Electronic fobs are now used to access all Park Paseo HOA facilities (including Clubhouse Pool, Prosa Pool, Tennis Courts, and Hot Tub). The old mechanical (Medeco) keys have been disabled.

Every Park Paseo resident (homeowner or tenant) must pick up the new key fobs in person at the HOA office at the clubhouse on Monday, Wednesday, or Friday between 9am - 5pm. Please bring a valid photo ID and your current metal (Medeco) keys to collect new key fobs.
